Football Association of Malaysia is ordered to pay a fine of USD10,000/- for violating Article 63 of the AFC Competition Operations Manual 2018.</p> <p>3. The fine shall be settled within 30 days from the date that this decision is communicated in accordance with Article 11.3 of the AFC Disciplinary and Ethics Code.</p> <p>4. Football Association of Malaysia is informed that a repeat violation of this provision may be met with more severe punishment.</p> <p>5. In accordance with Article 117.4 of the AFC Disciplinary and Ethics Code, Football Association of Malaysia is ordered to pay USD1,000/- in respect of the costs and expenses of the appeal.
